Course Description: This course will examine the popular music of each decade. Through discussions, projects, and activities students will learn: what styles of music were popular during each decade, popular artist's songs, what was going on in the world and our country during each decade, how people listened to music, the fashion of each decade, inventions and other firsts of each decade, and how music connects to your life. Grading will be based on student participation/effort and will be a pass or fail grade given at the end of each semester.
