Description:

This course will focus on reading, writing, listening, and speaking Spanish. Regular verbs and some irregular verbs in the present tense will be used with this vocabulary. There will be an emphasis on Spanish speaking countries and the culture of those countries.

Prerequisite:

Students must be at an eighth grade level or higher for this course.

Workload:

- Approximately 4 assignments per week. Each will take about 30 minutes to complete
- Quizzes may be frequent! They will be for students to gauge how they are doing in the class. There will be singing, acting, and role playing within many class periods.
- Grades will be based upon class participation, projects, homework, and test grades.
