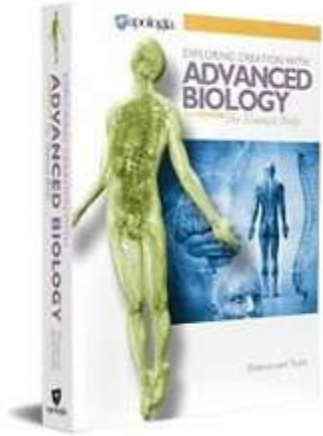

The class fulfills one high school science credit with a lab.

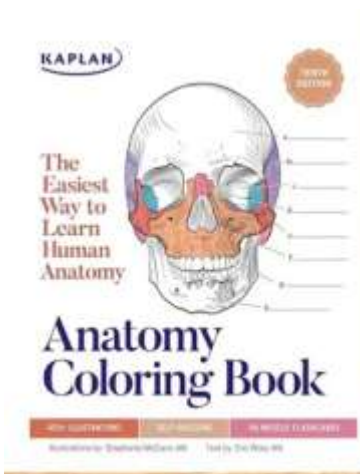
Homework
