## Course description:

This course will serve as an introduction into the technicalities of composition, color theory, and measurement while further honing observational skills and control over various mediums. Students will be guided in establishing a solid baseline with their creative skills, enabling them to get a feel for a variety of artistic techniques within each medium, and will be instructed in reproducing master works in order to refine their skills.

Pencil | Colored Pencil | Charcoal | Pastels | Acrylic Paint | Watercolor Paint

Requirements: Must have previously attended Art I or discussed with instructor.
