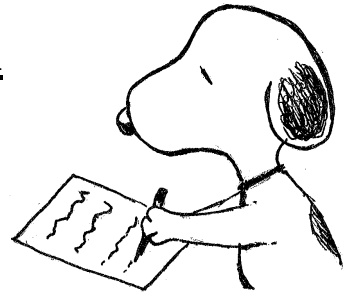


Middle School English
