Description:

This course will include a review of Spanish I. The skills of reading, writing, listening, and speaking Spanish will be emphasized. Verbs will be reviewed in the present tense. Students will learn many verbs in the present and preterite tenses. Topics for study include school and free time activities, making comparisons, daily routines, shopping, places in a town, and holiday celebrations. The cultural studies of countries where Spanish is spoken will also be continued from Spanish I.

Prerequisite:

Students must have completed Spanish I to take this course.

Workload:

- Approximately 4 assignments per week. Each will take about 30 minutes to complete.
- Quizzes may be frequent! They will be for students to gauge how they are doing in the class. There will be singing, acting, and role playing within many class periods.
- Grades will be based upon class participation, projects, homework, and test grades.
